Yesterday her appointment as territorial/administrative **archdeacon** of Woodstock became effective. Both will be formalized at Evening Prayer at the Cathedral on Sunday 16 November, 4 pm. Appointment as **canon** is merely an honour; it is conferred in this instance because this diocese has a rule that one cannot be an archdeacon without first being a canon.
